Anamnesis:

19.11.2010 A bird flew into the garage in the morning and overturned the vessel with used motor oil. Parts of the motor oil fell on the neck, back and wings of the bird.

The owner of the bird applied for help to OILSORB Ltd. to clean the bird from oil.

OILSORB absorbent granules (developed by OILSORB Ltd.) were used to clean the bird. After cleaning with absorbent granules, the duck was brought to the clinic for a veterinary examination.

The duck behaved appropriately, it was excited to a certain extent, but in spite of the accident and the subsequent handling and cleaning with chemicals, the duck behaved adequately.

The duck made several attempts to escape hitting us with a beak, and floundered a bit. The bird is active.

We did not detect any signs of agitation, apnoea, apathy or heavy breathing.

Paper towels were used to dry the bird's back and wings. After the cleaning, paper towels were slightly stained with oil residue, and the odour of oil-products spread across the room.

Despite oil residue, plumage did not stick together and looks normal; the structure of feathers is recognizable.

The bird was sent back home for further observation. In case the bird's health does not deteriorate, the owner of the bird will bring the bird for a re-examination after one week.

26.11.10 A clinical re-examination of the duck was carried out.

The owner of the bird did not have any complaints about the deterioration of the bird's health.

The bird is in good condition, moves and emits sounds actively, feeds regularly.

The duck is clinically healthy, no abnormal deviations have been observed. The state of plumage is normal.

Conclusion:

The duck's contamination with oil and subsequent cleaning of plumage with OILSORB absorbent granules did not cause any deviation from the normal state of health.

The duck has been clinically healthy for the entire period.
